2. Organisation's structure

We are an accredited deliverer of ILM and CMI training courses and run open and bespoke accredited training courses in Leadership & Management and Coaching & Mentoring and open and bespoke courses in Leadership, Coaching, Mindful Leadership, Mindful Coaching and short bitesize training programmes.

We are a small employer with 21 full and part time staff all in receipt of salaries above the national minimum wage.

3. Our supply chains

Our supply chains include sources of IT Service & Support, Office Equipment & Stationery.

4. Policy on Slavery and Human Trafficking

We will endeavour to ensure that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. We will achieve this by ensuring that all staff are paid above the national minimum wage and by raising awareness with staff to be vigilant when dealing with supply chain, and to raise any concerns relating to potential slavery and human trafficking with management immediately.

5. Supplier adherence

RDG will not tolerate any form of slavery and human trafficking. We expect all those in our supply chain and contractors to comply with our values.
